#### **Summer School in Humanitarian Action**

**Theme:** "Humanitarian Action in the context of Climate Change: Disaster Prevention, Innovative and Sustainable Technological Solutions"

#### Framework

The increase in global risks such as natural disasters, bio-ecological and environmental crises, health crises (commonly known as epidemics and pandemics), economic and social crises (wars or violent conflicts), derived essentially from human activity, generate a growing need for humanitarian action in the world. This action increasingly involves complex operations in challenging environments. The needs identified at the level of affected populations and infrastructures are multidimensional and pose serious challenges in formulating policies, programmes and projects, as well as in implementation, resource mobilisation and coordination of efforts among the various stakeholders.

Humanitarian Action involves several phases in its process, from the preparation to the assistance phase and the conclusion of this assistance. Many are the challenges that arise throughout the process and any approach requires an integrated vision of various areas of knowledge that allow not only to support this action, but also its planning, organization and monitoring of results. Addressing Humanitarian Action involves a multidisciplinary approach, which poses a challenge to those who, in organizations, enable this response, because as specialists in a particular area may not have the aggregated view of situations to develop the best response to each specific case. Providing effective humanitarian responses increasingly requires the professionalization of its agents and there is a growing demand for professionals with technical and reflective capacity in humanitarian action.

The Summer School on the theme "Humanitarian Action, Disaster Prevention and Innovative and Sustainable Technological Solutions", which will take place at the University of Cape Verde (Uni-CV) and the University of Santiago (US) between 29 May and 10 June 2023, is part of the HumanAct project "Humanitarian Action: Climate Change and Displacement" which began in 2020 and which, in addition to the aforementioned Cape Verdean universities, involves three universities from Mozambique - the Universidade Pedagógica (UP), the Universidade Púnguè (UniPúnguè), and the Universidade Rovuma (UniRovuma), one from Greece - the University of Athens and one Portuguese - the University Institute of Lisbon - ISCTE, which also ensures the overall coordination of the project.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

Promote interdisciplinary debates on Humanitarian Action in the context of climate change, its impact and the potential of innovative technologies as a mitigation and adaptation tool to increase resilience for developing countries.

## **METHODOLOGY**

There will be workshops, lectures, demonstrations, open talks and study visits, mediated by the use of active methodologies that provide critical literacy on the topics addressed. The Summer School will have as facilitators, professors from partner universities, speakers who are active in the area, national and international researchers with recognized experience in the subject matter.

Post-graduate students in the areas of Management, Health, Environment/International Relations and Diplomacy, totalling 30 students (15 from Uni-CV and 15 from US), as well as Professors and researchers are participating in this event.
